



Effective Questioning

May spark curiosity

May allow for collaboration before answering and allows all students to participate

Is carefully designed to extend and deepen learners' thinking

May include appropriate wait time, linked to collaboration for example

Assesses prior knowledge and understanding

Is planned and relates to the learning intentions and success criteria

Probes student responses, as appropriate, to unlock the depth of their learning

Turns mistakes into opportunities for learning when feedback is given on student responses

May encourage learners to explain and justify answers

Is a mixture of higher order and lower order questioning
